

Environmental Policy

GOALS

1. To, where practical, use equipment that has the minimum adverse environmental impact.
2. To, where possible, recycle all waste or to dispose of it in the correct manner.
3. To minimise the generation of waste.
4. To encourage employees to work in an environmentally responsible manner.
5. To, where possible, source and use local services and products to help reduce transport costs.
6. To encourage employees to use carbon efficient transport to get to work eg. Bike, bus, car pool.
7. To avoid unnecessary travel, and to use energy efficient vehicles and driving styles.
8. To make sure all employees are fully trained and competent when using any chemical that may adversely affect the environment, and to supply the means to use the chemicals in a safe manner.
9. To use electronic communication, where possible, as an alternative to paper.
10. To use contractors who have and apply the same environmental standards.
